Moscone in the chair explained that

wd be heard

At this point 2 men seized the microphone
& insisted on expressing their point of view
on the process as a whole, insisting the
procedure was a farce - they represented
the Labor Party & denounced the Mayor &
his colleagues as exploiters of the people -
some shouted at them angrily, some
clapped their hands to drive them
out, & Moscone advocated ignoring
them, saying they wd get tired &
go - this they did fairly soon

As there is a deficit of 462,000,000
Moscone is proposing that all depart-

ments and back - arguments as the
disc proceeded were on behalf of
increases for each off. - when the
assessors' off was considered, feeling was
high as homeowners assessments were
increased last yr - one woman sd:
"take the risk of welfare" - she wanted a
higher payroll tax, municipilization of
P.D. & E., etc tax banks and ins cos., not
illegal - another woman proposed a serv
tax on high rise bldgs - one man pro-
posed a variation of a commuter tax

A member of the Civil Serv Com,
when that off was disc'd, wanted more
gibs for minorities

When the Dist Atty's off came up, our
reason for being there was evident, as
several of our people lined up at the micro-
phones - each presented a partic point of
view based on his or her profession,
advocating more funds for the P.A.'s off -
those who spoke were Carolyn Lorman,
C. J. Jackson, Lee Ingram, Dave Skular,
Jack Beem - some people not connected
w/us also spoke, one saying the probl was
not prosec. of crime but gibs for young
people, esp. minorities
