I spend most of the day packing and moving

he still was not free to go - finally he allowed one

picked it up & took it by himself - I found another
man to help me w/ the other & they we moved it
at 4:30 the girls told me they had asked for
help in moving the crates all day but I did not
get any - their own crates had not been moved
