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all our people & we were seated gradually as space was made for us

The greater portion of their serv was a recording of a sermon which had begun before we arrived - about all I got from it were refs to Old Testament figures

at the end I was presented & he talked for about 2 mins, emphasizing his dislike for the Christ. relig. - the title "Christ. Ch" in our name was, he said, "a masquerade"

Their serv was over at about 5:30 - we boarded the buses - I changed my clothes on the bus - we did not get to the TC because we didn't have enough bag lunches for all, & to allow us to go to the bathroom.

An offering on the bus was taken by Lee Dygans⁵⁰ who said a crisis had arisen which necessitated J's going back immed. after the Lyndon man - he did not say whether he was driven or flew because of the crisis after funds were needed. I gave a dollar which I had

The buses left about 6:00 - I rd the CIA file

Another offering was taken by C. J. To whom I gave 3 dollars

I tried to sleep but the bus was terribly crowded; the child in the aisle brushed against me, babies cried - I did not succeed in getting to sleep by we reached the next stop at 8:30 - we were told we had 15 mins only to get to the bathroom

When we boarded the buses again we had read a msg from the stop that (1) we were in a serious crisis & we had to take another offering & (2) as many as possible go to the Hotel Room when we arrived in SF at 3:00 & when we there - C. J. the charge of getting people to volunteer for both - he gave us a long speech about seeing us the battlefield which was much overdue - I had already given more than usual & felt my wife would suffer if I missed sleep from 3:00 to 6:00, esp. since it was obvious I wasn't going to get much on the bus - I did not give or pledge more & did not sign up for the writing

Later we came through that 2 articles about J & the Ts were appearing in the M paper exactly as I had predicted, but they were on the whole favorable, & only those who had not written previously should go to the Hotel Room to do so -

I managed to sleep 3 hrs at most and
